### School of Education - Summer Conference - Engagement Opportunity

Helen Bowhay, Director of Initial Teacher Education, has asked if any NST schools would be willing to support their plans for their summer conference in 2025. This year they want to focus on pupil voice around the concept of place and belonging...

"Our vision for the conference would be that we hand the event over to our pupils to provide them with a space to voice what it is they think we (leaders and teachers) need to know about what makes them feel like they belong in school and education more broadly, or conversely, what makes them feel like they don't belong. Ideally they would be able to 'voice' this in whatever way they want to e.g. it could be art, drama, video or just talking. We are hopeful we can get schools to commit to being involved and work with their pupils to help them share the important messages they feel we need to hear.

We are meeting as a group on Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> November, 2.30pm, so anyone wanting to be involved would be welcome to join us – this will just be adults in the first instance!"
