Attached is a copy of the latest newsletter from the Flying High English Hub, for your information.

Rattle and Roll

I am reaching out from Rattle and Roll, through Pat, as we have worked with your Trust before and can offer 2 key opportunities to all NST schools. These two options **do no require any input from school**, but **bring in much needed funds to your budget**. All our provision is run as an inclusive 'pop up' set up: with our office staffed 10am-6pm (term time) and 8am-6pm (during holidays) for parents; our own bespoke booking platform; our own DSLs; and Ofsted registrations etc so there really is no impact/extra work for schools - if anything this is reduced!

Wraparound Care (funding available NOW)

We have been awarded large sums of funding for new wraparound care in both Nottingham County and City with the new initiatives focused on all schools having wraparound provision. We offer this for children aged 3-11 to ensure school nursery parents can access the extended day provision (as well as holiday provision outlined below). Our sessions are Ofsted Outstanding and structured with a focussed session each night i.e. sports, drama, dance, yoga etc. As we are a large organisation with many sites across Nottinghamshire we have a large, high quality staff base to cover all provision needs.

There is funding available NOW to set up new wraparound provisions this year that we can apply for – but this funding may not be around for long as it is being reviewed asap by the new Government. If this is something you are interested in please let me know ASAP and we can explore this further.

HAF – Holiday Activity Fund Holiday Clubs

We are Notts County and City's biggest provider of HAF holiday clubs – these are FREE to children who receive benefits related free school meals (and include lunch and snacks), and we offer paid places to those who don't qualify for the funded ones. We provide highly qualified staff, equipment and planning to offer your children structured and engaging holiday provision. These clubs also offer a safe environment for children to attend where our staff are able to have an 'eyes on' impact especially during the longer summer holidays. We manage referrals etc ourselves (and share with schools on return). The funding window for these holiday clubs is opening again in the new year so please let me know ASAP if you would like your school to be a host school. We pay a daily rent for the hire of your school.

To conclude - wraparound care is going to be legislated across all schools soon and needs to cover your nursery children – and now is the time to explore whilst the funding is available. HAF funding looks set to continue under the new Government meaning together wraparound and holiday clubs can offer 'extended hours' for all parents who need it.
