#### Interested? Here's what you really need to know:


- ✓ Applications will open in **February** and cohorts start in April.

Want to develop your understanding of mathematical concepts and how to support young children to develop a firm foundation in early maths – then this is for you:

**Audience: Developing Early Number Sense 4-5s** is specifically for practitioners working within a reception class

**Developing Early Number Sense 3-4s** is specifically for practitioners working with preschool children in schools or PVIs

**Course Overview:** These courses will develop practitioner subject knowledge and give research-based theories and practical ideas of how adults can develop early number sense with reception and pre-school children. Both sessions are designed to compliment any schemes which might be used and aim to develop practitioner understanding of early number acquisition and deepen subject knowledge.

- Understand how to develop a mathematically engaging environment
