L3 Qualification for Teaching Assistants

The AIM Group have a NCFE Level 3 Diploma in Children & Young People's Workforce, which is completely FREE of charge for all TAs and one-to-ones.

Details:

- Self-study over 9 months
- Allocated Tutor Support
- No need to attend a college
- 2-hour Bi-Weekly Online session via Microsoft Teams with Tutor (held in the evening)
- 3-4 online, virtual observations throughout the 9-month course

Eligibility Criteria:

- Must be aged 19 or over as of 31st August 2024
- Have been living in the UK or EU for the past 3 years
- Not currently completing another Government funded course
- Access to a laptop or computer at home
- Contracted as a TA or one-to-one
- Working with Year Groups Year 1 or above
- Must be earning less than £25,000 per year
